Susan B. Gunnewig, M.Ed. is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston. She is also the Associate Director of the Center for Improving the Readiness of Children for Learning and Education (CIRCLE). The center has a staff of over 40 staff in the research, clinical and educational areas. Grants projects are funded by NIH, NICHD, DOE, IERI, and TEA. Recently the Center was given the mandate of implementing the research project as a part of Texas SB 76 in 15 communities across Texas. The results of this project will provide information for the Texas legislature in the Spring of 2005. Ms. Gunnewig has presented at a number of conferences and conventions across the nation such as the DOE Early Educator Academies and the Even Start Academies. In addition, Ms. Gunnewig supervised the development and training of the STEP Head Start professional development. Prior to joining CIRCLE, she was a classroom teacher and central staff administrator in the Houston Independent School District for 32 years.
